


Application type	Cloud service, running on CamStreamer servers with encrypted communication with cameras via in-camera ACAP app, uploaded into the camera (installed by the user-friendly wizard)
Camera compatibility	All Axis cameras (with firmware version 6.50 and higher)
Security and safety	Secure TLS communication between camera, CamStreamer Cloud, browser and mobile app. High availability of CamStreamer Cloud service. Servers are in multiple geographical locations. Automatic backup of cloud recordings.
